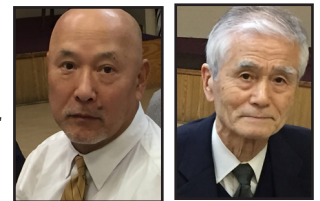


Gardena Church members "sew" up for seniors

"We donated our property and decades of service to Keiro. We didn't know the nursing homes will be sold away."



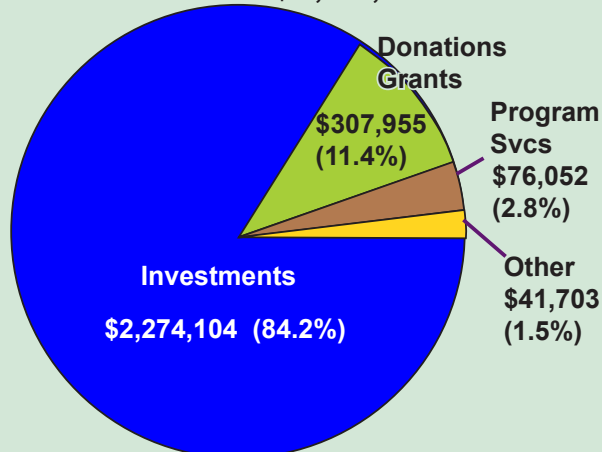
